End-of-life care




- Focuses on comfort and symptom management: whole-person care
- Can be provided alongside
 aggressive care such as chemo or
 blood transfusions




- Focuses on comfort and symptom management: whole-person care
- Must have a terminal diagnosis
 with a prognosis of six months or
 less
- Cannot receive aggressive
 treatment for the underlying
 disease, only symptom
 management



Who becomes a death doula?

What a death doula does

- Help those in a patient's circle of care discuss, understand, accept prognosis
- Assist with end-of-life planning
- Connect clients with community resources

- Serve as an advocate with health care team
- Facilitate remembrance services
- Provide bereavement counseling and referrals

What a death doula does

- Help patients and loved ones sort through and understand options
- Facilitate discussions about hard choices
- Offer end-of-life education
- Translate confusing jargon
- Offer physical comfort

- Discuss spiritual and existential concerns
- Sit with uncertainty
- Provide space for conversation as well as quiet
- Affirm and support choices
- Sit vigil and model doing so



Who oversees death doulas?

- Doulas aren't regulated, licensed, or licensed by a national body.
- Typically, death doulas are self-employed.
- A doula may have minimal training, education, and experience in how to provide spiritual and emotional support.



Who pays for a death doula?
